# **CROSSING FOR KJ**



On September 9th, 28 paddlers crossed the Catalina Channel from Avalon to Long Beach in honor of Kobe Jackson. This was the second annual "Crossing for KJ". There were 13 solo paddlers and 4 relay teams made up of Kobe's friends, family, and co-workers.

Kobe suddenly passed away two years ago on August 25, 2021. Kobe greatly valued his aquatics background - as a Wilson High School swim and water polo alumni, and as a Long Beach Lifeguard. Friends and family started an annual crossing to raise money for the Crossing for Kobe scholarship to support aquatics, lifeguarding, and education.

The majority of the 28 paddlers are ocean lifeguards from Long Beach, Seal Beach, and other local agencies. The team is grateful the lifeguarding and aquatics community has come together to support him and his family. The hope is that the paddle keeps growing each year in Kobe's honor!
